NEW FEATURE ADDED TO CITY OF VALLEJO WEBSITE: E-NEWS

VALLEJO – Residents of the City of Vallejo – or anyone else interested in what’s happening in the city – now have an easier way of knowing when the City’s web site has been updated.

The new website feature, called “E-News Automatic Delivery System,” allows visitors to register to receive updates on multiple categories listed on the site.

Once signed up for the E-News System, participants will receive an e-mail notification within half an hour after the updates have been posted on the site.

“It’s a great tool to improve the collaboration between businesses, citizens, and the City of Vallejo. In addition, it will save staff resources by pushing automatic updates out to the public,” said Gonzalo Gonzalez, Chief Information Officer for the City of Vallejo. “For example, businesses that might want to participate in various bidding opportunities can now sign up for this service and be notified automatically when a new bid listing is posted without having to check the city’s website on a regular basis.”

Similarly, residents who want to know what is on the next City Council agenda, Press Releases, Employment Opportunities, and others, will also be notified when they are posted.

“It’s a useful tool that takes less than five minutes to sign up” Gonzalez said.

The City has been working to improve its website for some time now, starting with a redesign and adding various upgrade to the site. Residents can now pay their water bills on line, submit electronic forms to city staff, schedule and pay for some building permits, and access various online services as well.

“We’re trying to improve our level of service to our residents,” said City Manager David Martinez. “We’ve received many compliments on the new site. This new feature is just one more positive addition.”
