

CITY OF VALLEJO DEDICATES FIRE AND POLICE MEMORIAL

VALLEJO - Vallejo Fire, Police and City officials and dignitaries unveiled a monument to honor Vallejo's fallen fire and police officers at City Hall. The monument will honor those who have made the ultimate sacrifice while serving the citizens of Vallejo.

The monument, unveiled May 8, was placed just outside the entrance to City Hall and will bear the names of fire and police officers that have lost their lives in the line of duty.

The names on the monument are Firefighter/Engineer Robbin Mackbee, who lost his life at a fire on July 28, 1980; Police Officer Calvin Thacker, Badge #220 and Officer William Eason, Badge #227, who lost their lives on April 7, 1966; and Officer Jeffery Azuar, Badge #371, who lost his life on April 12, 2000.

Family and friends of the fallen officers unveiled the monument at the ceremony. Contributors to the purchase of the monument were made by the Vallejo Police Officers Association, the International Association of Firefighters Local 1186, Kaiser Permanente AACC and the City of Vallejo.
