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VACANCIES ON ARCHITECTURAL HERITAGE AND LANDMARKS COMMISSION AND BEAUTIFICATION ADVISORY COMMISSION

Anyone interested in being considered for appointment to the City of Vallejo's Architectural Heritage and Landmarks Commission (AHLC) or Beautification Advisory Commission (BAC) may submit a formal application with the Vallejo City Clerk no later than Friday, <u>January 28, 2011.</u>

There is currently one vacancy on the AHLC and six expired terms. Commissioners must have a demonstrated talent or interest in aesthetics, architectural design or cultural heritage, either through background, experience, training, education or occupation. The duties of this Commission are defined in the Vallejo Municipal Code Chapter 2.48. The Commission meets the third Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall.

There are currently three vacancies on the BAC and six expired terms. The purpose of this commission is to advise the Council on all matters pertaining to beautification of the City and to stimulate residents and property owners to carry out City Council approved plans for beautification of the City. The duties of this Commission are defined in the Vallejo Municipal Code Chapter 2.30. The Commission meets the last Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall.

Commission members must be residents of the City and at least 18 years of age.
