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VACANCIES ON LIBRARY BOARD

Anyone interested in being considered for appointment to the City of Vallejo's Library Board may submit a formal application with the Vallejo City Clerk no later than Friday, February 11, 2011.

The Library Board consists of seven members. There are currently three vacancies and one expired term on the Board. The purpose of this Board is to advise the Council and City Manager on matters of policy and public interest related to the management, use and preservation of library facilities and property, to investigate and make advisory reports on such matters, and to render other specific services consistent with the role of an advisory board on the library system, including recommendations and advice to the County librarian on matters related to the library system within the City of Vallejo. The duties of this Commission are defined in the Vallejo Municipal Code Chapter 2.51. The Commission meets the first Thursday every other month at 6:30 p.m. at the JFK Library.

Board members must be residents of the City and at least 18 years of age. Terms are for a period of four years and members may serve two terms.
