The City of Vallejo is the sponsor of the Vallejo Station Intermodal Facility Project. The project includes the two level 1200-space Vallejo Station Parking Structure, the Vallejo Bus Transit Center, and the Vallejo Baylink Ferry Terminal. The parking garage, to be constructed in two Phases, will serve the 2,500 daily patrons of the Baylink Ferry.

Upon completion of Phase I (early 2012), the City will implement a comprehensive parking management program with the goals of

- ensuring adequate parking for ferry commuters without impacting parking for downtown shoppers and residents

- information on the parking garage project
- an overview of parking policy and parking management
- options for parking technology in the new garage and surrounding areas
