CITY TO HOLD STUDY SESSION ON FIRE DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

The City of Vallejo will hold a study session at 7 p.m. on Monday, July 10, 2006 to describe the study methodology and to obtain public comments and questions of the private company conducting the study of Vallejo Fire Department resources. The study session, facilitated by Citygate Associates, will be held in Vallejo City Council Chambers, 555 Santa Clara St.

The following topics will be addressed at this forum:

- An analysis of the effectiveness of Vallejo's current fire station locations.
- An analysis of the efficiency of the current deployment scheme of resources within the City's fire stations.
- An analysis of the Fire Department's ability to meet the listed standards.
- Recommendations for changes in fire station locations to meet the current needs of the City and to optimize service delivery.
- Recommendations for new fire station locations to meet the growth needs of the City.
- Recommendations for deployment of existing resources within the City's fire stations to optimize service delivery.
- Recommendations for deployment of new resources to meet current and future needs.

Citygate Associates were hired by the City Council to examine the Fire Department's ability to provide services to the citizens of Vallejo and are seeking public input in the process.
