WATERFRONT TREE LIGHTING CEREMONIES SET FOR DECEMBER 3

VALLEJO – The Beautification Advisory Commission of the City of Vallejo will be hosting the eighth annual Holiday Tree Lighting on Saturday, Dec. 3, 2005.

The event, which begins at 5 p.m., will take place at the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, 495 Mare Island Way. Scheduled activities and will include the presentation of colors, carols by the Vallejo Chorus and a Brass Quartet, and a visit by Santa and his elves.

“We want this to be a family event for everyone in Vallejo,” said Chris Krzak, member of the Beautification Advisory Commission.

Following the tree lighting, a lighted boat parade featuring members of the Vallejo Yacht Club and other Vallejo Marina berthers will also take place on the Carquinez Strait.
