Robles Street Homicide Arrest

On November 25, 2012, Vallejo Police Officers responded to the area of 300 Robles regarding multiple calls of shots fired.

Upon the arrival of officers, they discovered a 17 year old boy dead, the victim of gunfire. Initial reports indicated that a physical fight had taken place between the 17 year old homicide victim and a 19 year old male, both of whom were attendees at a gathering in the area.

Through witness statements and information revealed through the investigation, 44 year old Vallejo resident Randee Demar Williams, the father of the 19 year old, was identified as the shooter in the case.

Officers surrounded his home in the 1000 block of Thelma in Vallejo where he was taken into custody without further incident. He was interviewed, processed and later booked into the Solano County Jail on a charge of Murder.
