Missing Person at Risk - Elderly Man

On Sunday, December 9, 2012, at 8:25 AM, Vallejo Police Officers were dispatched onto Mare Island on the report of a missing elderly man. Officers responded to the area of 980 Nimitz Drive, Berth #10.

The missing elderly man was identified as Philip Steven MATTINGLY, aged 77. He is a white male who is 6-1, 210 lbs, with white hair and blue eyes.

Mr. Mattingly's son was on scene and provided information to the police. Mr. Mattingly had been working on his tugboat named the "Eugene H." berthed at Berth#10 on the east shore of Mare Island. The "Eugene H." tugboat was anchored alongside the WW2 Ship USS LCS 102. Mr. Mattingly was last seen on his tugboat by a friend on Saturday, December 8, 2012, at approximately 5:00 PM. Officers found Mr. Mattingly's truck parked at the scene.

Vallejo Police Officers conducted an investigation and determined that at this point, there are no indications of foul play. Officers are concerned that Mr. Mattingly's age and health may have contributed to his disappearance.

Vallejo Police Officers worked closely with the U.S. Coast Guard and the Solano County Office of Emergency Services (O.E.S.) dive team in a coordinated search for Mr. Mattingly on December 9, 2012. The U.S. Coast Guard searched the shorelines around Mare Island, while the Solano O.E.S. put divers in the water.


The search for Mr. Mattingly continues today with the continued assistance of the U.S. Coast Guard and Solano O.E.S.
