On Friday August 29, 2008, at approximately 11:28 PM, an 18 year old male resident of Vallejo was driving his vehicle, with two other passengers, westbound in the 3000 block of Georgia St. For unknown reasons, he lost control of his vehicle and drove into the center median.

The center median, in this area of Georgia St, is comprised of shrubbery and trees. The vehicle impacted and severed a tree which caused the vehicle to overturn. The vehicle came to rest upside down against another tree. The druver was transported by Medic Ambulance to Kaiser Hospital, Vallejo, where he was later pronounced deceased.

One of the passengers, a 14 year old male resident of Vallejo, was airlifted to John Muir Trauma Center, Walnut Creek. The passenger suffered a broken hip and lacerations to his head. Another male passenger, a 15 year old resident of Vallejo, was transported by Medic Ambulance to Kaiser Hospital, Vallejo, suffering from a minor laceration to his left hand.

The collision is under investigation. The identities of all involved parties are being withheld pending family notification.
