On 10/28/08, Dvondre Bernard Woodards was served with arrest warrants stemming from the officer involved shooting that occurred on 10/23/08 at 1 Curtola Pkwy.

Upon being discharged from the hospital, Woodards was booked into the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office Martinez jail facility on a complaint filed with the Solano County District Attorney's Office. This complaint resulted in the issuance of a warrant for brandishing a handgun at a peace officer, weapons violations, and possessing a stolen handgun. Woodards bail was set at \$100,000.00.

### OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

On Thursday, October 23, 2008 at approximately 8:44 p.m., Vallejo Police Special Operations Section Detectives were on patrol in the area of Marin St. and Curtola Parkway. They observed a subject running from the Marin Market towards a waiting vehicle with two other individuals. Noticing that the subject on foot was trying to get into the back of the vehicle as it was driving away; the officers suspected that a Robbery may have just taken place.

When the officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop near #1 Curtola Parkway, the vehicle only slowed. Suddenly, the subject in the back seat exited with a handgun and pointed it in the direction of the officers while the vehicle accelerated away. Fearing for their lives and the safety of others, the officers fired their duty weapons at suspect wounding him.

The suspect, Dvondre Woodards (age 19 from Vallejo) continued to resist apprehension but was taken into custody without further incident. Woodards was transported to an area hospital and is in stable condition.

Fortunately, no Vallejo Police Officers or nearby citizens were injured.

As is routine protocol, this incident is being reviewed by the Solano County District Attorneys Office in conjunction with the Vallejo Police Department investigation.
