## CITY OF VALLEJO THIRD ANNUAL RECYCLED SCULPTURE & ARTWORK CONTEST

The City of Vallejo Public Works Department Recycling Division is hosting the 3rd Annual Recycled Sculpture and Artwork contest on Saturday, April 20, 2013. In honor of Earth Day 2013, the event will be held in conjunction with the Farmers Market on Georgia Street and Virginia Street, 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Vallejo residents will be challenged to turn recyclable materials into creative and original pieces of art. The grand prize will be up to \$1,000. All prizes will be awarded at the event. Entries must be received no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 12, 2013. The artwork will be judged on creativity, originality, and the most imaginative use of recyclable materials.

The contest aims to change the perception about these materials that are commonly viewed as trash, and to educate about the 3 R's: Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. All artwork must be fabricated from 100% found, reused, and/or, recyclable materials. Various pieces of art will be displayed in the lobby of City Hall during the week prior to Earth Day, April 15 – 19, 2013.

Donations provided by local businesses will allow three contest categories: Adult, Junior & Elementary. The recycled art work will be judged by sponsoring businesses and a member of the Chamber of Commerce. The City reserves the right to keep all art work to be displayed at future events.
