Vallejo Hydromodification Management Plan Public Outreach and Preparation for Municipal Implementation

The City of Vallejo and the Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District are required by the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board 2009 Municipal Regional Permit (MRP) to develop a Hydromodification Management Plan (HMP). The purpose of the plan is to ensure that runoff from new and significant redevelopment within the City of Vallejo is managed so as to avoid adverse impacts on stream erosion and infrastructure. A draft version of the Plan was submitted to the Regional Board in March 2012 for their review and ultimate approval. The purpose of this workshop is to inform the public on the requirements of the HMP, the basis and rationale for those requirements, the tools provided in the HMP that will be available to developers to meet those requirements, and the schedule for implementation of the HMP.
