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ADMIRAL CALLAGHAN LANE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT NOTICE

On May 28, the Vallejo City Council awarded a construction contract to MCK Services Inc. for pavement rehabilitation on Admiral Callaghan Lane, between Turner Parkway and Columbus Parkway (map attached).

The project involves grinding and removing of existing asphalt pavement and replacing with new pavement. Before re-paving, handicap curb ramps will be reconstructed to current standards. After paving is complete new roadway striping will be installed.

Construction operations are anticipated to begin by July 2013 and be completed by September 2013. Night work will be involved at the intersection of Plaza Drive to minimize traffic obstructions and delays to consumers. During construction, the streets in and around the work area will be signed for detours and/or closures as necessary.

The City appreciates the patience and understanding of residents and visitors during construction and will be diligent to minimize impacts and traffic delays. Project information is forthcoming and will be accessible on the City of Vallejo's [Capital Project \(CIP\)](#) webpage.

The project is fully funded by [Measure B](#), the voter-approved one percent sales tax to enhance City of Vallejo services, approved by voters on November 8, 2011. Measure B funds are used to resolve both resident and City Council identified issues and concerns within the City of Vallejo. The Measure will expire on March 31, 2022. Measure B funds are budgeted as part of the annual budget approval process by Vallejo City Council.

In FY 12/13, the City Council allocated nearly \$2 Million to fund Street Maintenance. Approximately \$575,000 was allocated towards the Slurry Seal Project which provided a relatively inexpensive preventative maintenance approach to extend the life of 134 roads to avoid worsening conditions. The remaining \$1,125,000 was allocated to Street Maintenance and Rehabilitation for this project improvement.
