Robbery arrest

On Aug 14th at approximately 1:35 am, Vallejo Police received a report of a street robbery that just occurred in the area of Tennessee @ Amador streets. A 24 year old male victim indicated that he was approached by three unknown black male adult suspects, all of whom suddenly attacked and beat the victim, then fled with his personal belongings; the victim suffered minor injuries. While officers were making contact with the victim, another Vallejo Police unit indicated that they were being flagged down by two citizens in the area of Florida @ Amador. The two citizens indicated to police that three individuals just tried to steal their personal belongings; victim then immediately pointed out three suspects who were walking away from the immediate area.

Upon being challenged by the police, one of the suspects quickly surrendered. The second and third suspects fled from officers by hopping over residential yard fences. One of the two outstanding suspects was ultimately apprehended on the 400 block of Amador St and the third suspect remains at large. Vallejo officers recovered both evidence and suspected narcotics apparently discarded by the suspects. At the conclusion of this event, officers subsequently arrested both subjects for robbery and possession of ecstasy and they were booked into Solano County jail.

Suspect #1 is Davonte Morris, 21 year old Vallejo resident

Suspect #2 is Emil Cochran, 22 year old Vallejo resident

Suspect #3 remains at large and he's being described as a black male adult in his 20's
