Marina Improvements

Many Marina customers may have already noticed the tremendous amount of work that has been done over the past several months. We would like to share with you some of what has been done as of now.

- Some of the trip hazards along the promenade have been repaired.
- Two arbors were removed as they had extensive dry rot.
- The guest dock has been re-planked and repairs were made to the electrical & water lines.
- G dock now has water and the decking has been repaired.
- The gangways on E, F have been rebuilt.
- Electrical conduits have been inspected and necessary repairs were made on all docks.
- All parking lots in the Marina have been re-stripped.
- Removal of several sunken and derelict vessels by receiving an AWAFF (abandoned watercraft abatement fund) grant from the Department of Boating & Waterways.

Black Talon Security

We have a new janitorial service that started October 1st. Universal Building Services is now responsible for cleaning all Marina restrooms, the laundry room, and the Marina office. Garbage Removal & Oil Recycling

Approximately twenty seven truck loads of garbage and debris were removed from the docks in the North Basin. Staff removed items such as microwave ovens, mini refrigerators, hoses, plywood tables and even abandoned steps. We would like to let you know that there are several dumpsters and garbage cans located in the Marina. Please do not leave your garbage on the docks. This is not only a tripping hazard, but it is unsightly as well.

For your convenience, oil recycling is available. Please contact the Marina office to arrange for the containment area to be unlocked. Please do not leave your oil and bilge pads at the oil containment area.
