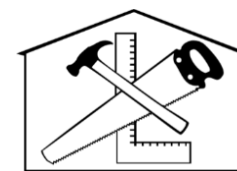

<input type="checkbox"/> Safer Streets - Bike Lanes & Markings Students/all citizens benefit from increased safety on roads with Bicycle Lanes, Signs and Markings along selected Vallejo streets. City has final discretion for location and type. Ride Safely! <i>LOCATION: Citywide</i>		\$ 130,000 PARTNER: Public Works
<input type="checkbox"/> Break the Cycle: Math Development for Most At-Risk 12 month mathematics program for middle-school students who are most at risk of failing; to provide building blocks to equip underrepresented youth for STEM literacy. Estimated to serve 50 youth. <i>LOCATION: 1709 Sonoma Blvd.</i>		\$ 40,000 PARTNER: Club Stride
<input type="checkbox"/> Debt Free Vallejo Workshops that provide information, tools and guidance to gain financial freedom, making possible goals such as higher education, starting a business or buying a home. Estimated to serve 420 people. <i>LOCATION: 1905 Florida St.</i>		\$ 50,000 PARTNER: New Dawn
<input type="checkbox"/> Afterschool: Do You Want To Be A First Responder? This is an afterschool class for 6th-8th students to learn about public safety careers from firefighters, police and other first responder professionals. Estimated to serve 300 youth. <i>LOCATION: Schools serving students in grades 6th-8th</i>		\$ 25,000 PARTNER: VCUSD
<input type="checkbox"/> 9-1-1 Emergency Call Center Equipment Purchase equipment to replace the outdated computer system currently used to dispatch 9-1-1 emergency calls. <i>LOCATION: Vallejo Police Department Communications Center</i>		\$ 400,000 PARTNER: Police Department
<input type="checkbox"/> Drought Tolerant Landscape Demonstration Garden Transform the landscape surrounding the Vallejo Senior Center into a drought resistant garden and native plant sanctuary where citizens can get educated on low water plants and irrigation systems. <i>LOCATION: Florence Douglas Senior Center - 333 Amador St.</i>		\$ 50,000 PARTNER: Public Works

<input type="checkbox"/> Air Monitoring Network for Hazardous Materials A network of devices that monitor dangerous and hazardous airborne materials to alert the Fire Department for further action and protect the health and safety of all. <i>LOCATION: Determined by Fire Department</i>		\$ 150,000 PARTNER: Fire Department
<input type="checkbox"/> Fixing Pets and Feral Cats for Better Health Humane program for affordable neutering of pet cats, dogs and feral cats. Also helps residents trap, neuter and return feral cats. Less allergies, property damage, and nuisance odors for Vallejoans. <i>LOCATION: Citywide</i>		\$ 50,000 PARTNER: City of Vallejo
<input type="checkbox"/> Water Break Repair Equipment This project will provide funding to the Water Division and allow for the purchase of a Vac-Con Hydro Xcavator truck to expedite and minimize the impact of water line breaks. <i>LOCATION: Citywide</i>		\$ 400,000 PARTNER: Public Works
<input type="checkbox"/> Afterschool S.T.E.A.M. Machines This course will engage youth in one of 5 courses; Forensic Science, Alternative Energy, Robotics, architecture, and Media Literacy, at the Immersive Learning Center. Estimated to serve 196 students. <i>LOCATION: Immersive Learning Center, 250 Georgia St.</i>		\$ 50,000 PARTNER: World Peace Through Technology
<input type="checkbox"/> Pedestrian Safety and Traffic Calming Installation of traffic calming measures such as flashing beacons, high visibility crosswalks, and bulb-outs around needed crosswalks and high-speed streets in Vallejo, as determined by Public Works. <i>LOCATION: Citywide</i>		\$ 400,000 PARTNER: Public Works
<input type="checkbox"/> Street and Pothole Repair This project will supplement the street repair budget to target roads where funding does not exist, as determined by Public Works Engineers and the Pavement Condition Index. <i>LOCATION: Citywide</i>		\$ 400,000 PARTNER: Public Works
<input type="checkbox"/> Help for Families Dealing With Addiction A Family outreach program to educate and empower families through drug education, prevention and intervention. The program will focus on healing families who have been impacted by substance abuse. Estimated to serve 60 people. <i>LOCATION: 627 Grant St.</i>		\$ 50,000 PARTNER: House of Acts
<input type="checkbox"/> Afterschool: Mindfulness and Yoga Class for Youth Afterschool mindfulness classes for Vallejo youth with meditation, yoga and social-emotional learning for fun, improved self-control, and increased self/social awareness. Estimated to serve 480 youth. <i>LOCATIONS: K – 12 Schools</i>		\$ 35,000 PARTNER: VCUSD
