Vallejo Police detectives have been investigating a homicide resulting from a shooting which occurred on January 28, 2009. Officers responded to a call of multiple shots heard in the area of Nebraska St and Sonoma Blvd. Officers located a 15 year old male Vallejo resident lying down in the 200 block of Nebraska Street suffering from a gunshot wound.

On Saturday, January 31, 2009, it was determined that the victim had ceased to maintain brain activity. With family present, it was decided that life support to the victim would be discontinued.

Vallejo Police Detectives have developed leads which led to the arrests of four of the five suspects in the case. Detectives were actively searching for the final suspect in the case, Alonzo Wilson.

On February 25, Vallejo detectives were in contact with Wilson and/or his representative in an attempt to have him surrender to authorities. Late afternoon on February 25, Wilson surrendered himself to Vallejo detectives in Fairfield. Wilson was arrested for Murder and booked into the Solano County Jail.

Wilson has had prior contact with police. There are no more suspects being sought in this case at this time.

On January 28, 2009, at approximately 8:19 PM, Vallejo Police Officers responded to a call of multiple shots heard in the area of Nebraska St and Sonoma Blvd.

Officers located a 15 year old male Vallejo resident lying down in the 200 block of Nebraska Street suffering from a gunshot wound.

On Saturday, January 31, 2009, it was determined that the victim had ceased to maintain brain activity. With family present, it was decided that life support to the victim would be discontinued. The victim was pronounced dead at approximately 2:30 PM.

The case is now considered a homicide. This was the second homicide of the year.

Vallejo Police Detectives have developed leads in this case which led to the arrests of four of the five suspects in the case. The adult arrests are Shane Peters 18 of Vallejo, Richard Eads 19 of Vallejo, and Dale Coley 19 years of Vallejo.

A juvenile was also arrested for the murder. His name is being withheld because of his age pending prosecution strategies.

Still outstanding is the final suspect in the case Alonzo Wilson.

Alonzo Wilson is described as a BMA, 5'6", 165 pounds and is 19 years old from Vallejo.



**In Custody**

If Alonzo Wilson is discovered do not approach him but call the Vallejo Police or 911 and report the sighting.

The motive in the case appears to be gang related however it appears that the victim in the case was not the target of the original shooting. By all accounts he was an innocent bystander who was in the wrong place at the wrong time.
