On Tuesday, July 21, 2009 at 6:26 pm, officers were dispatched to a call of shots fired in the 500 block of Wallace Ave. Officers located two injured parties, Michael Moore 26, and Henry Kearn 73, both from Oakland, who had suffered shotgun wounds. Moore sustained a major injury to his left arm, while Kearn suffered minor injuries to his torso. Both injuries are considered non-life threatening. Moore was taken to John Muir Medical Center, while Kearn was transported to a local hospital.

According to witnesses, the victims, along with two other subjects, were near a vehicle in front of the residence of Mateo Hilton-Draquett 27. Information indicated that the subjects involved are familiar with one another from a time when Hilton-Draquett resided in Oakland. He recently moved to Vallejo.

Apparently, Hilton-Draquett exited the residence with a shotgun and approached the group. Several shots were fired striking the two victims before Hilton-Draquett fled the scene.

Hilton-Draquett is an ex-felon, possibly armed. The weapon is still outstanding.
