ARMED ROBBERY WITH SUSPECTED DYNAMITE

On October 16, 2009 at approximately 10:13 a.m. two masked and armed suspects entered the Cash & Go in the 200 block of Tennessee Street. One suspect was armed with a semi automatic handgun and the other suspect was armed with a bundle of suspected dynamite. They robbed the customers and employees and fled in a silver Volvo heading west on Tennessee Street.

Even though no explosion occurred, the Vallejo Police is releasing surveillance photographs of the suspects due to the atypical presence of dynamite in the commission of a robbery.

Police are asking the public to carefully view the photographs and call detectives with any information. The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF&E) has been asked to help in this investigation.

The suspects are described as:

Suspect 1: Black male, 5'-9 to 6', 150 to 170 pounds, black hooded jacket, dark bandana, blue jeans with a large frame black semi auto handgun.

Suspect 2: Black male, 5'6 to 5'9, 140 to 170 pounds, black hooded jacket, dark bandana, black pants holding suspected dynamite.

Vehicle: 1978 to 1980 Volvo, Silver in color, 240 type model with tinted windows peeling in the back and loud exhaust. One suspect was seen in the getaway car with dreadlocks.
