SUSPECTS WANTED IN SHOOTING



On November 11, 2009, the above suspects were in the area of South Vallejo when the victim and his 5 year old daughter were walking in the area. He recognized the female suspect, Leslie Quist, and had a brief conversation with her as she was seated in her vehicle. The male suspect, Shawn Morita, became jealous and exited the vehicle, firing several shots and the victim and his daughter. The victim was struck once, but the child was unharmed.

These suspects are homeless and are believed to be staying in motels in Contra Costa, Napa, and in Solano County.

Suspect vehicle is a 2007 Pontiac Grand Am or grand Prix, primer grey with a possible license plate of Cal #6JAD000.

Shawn Morita is a parolee at large. He is described as a Guamanian male, 5-2, 140 lbs, and may have cut off his hair. He is considered armed and dangerous.

Leslie Marie Quist is an ex-felon on parole. She is described as a white female, 5-6, 170 lbs, hazel eyes and brown hair.
