False Alarm Awareness Class Now Available On-Line

The Vallejo Municipal Code imposes monetary penalties on owners of alarm systems causing the Police Department to respond to false alarms.

The Code also provides for the waiver of one false alarm penalty for those owners completing a False Alarm Awareness Class. This waiver may be obtained only once every 12 months.

The class is offered approximately every four months at the Police Department. To make the class more convenient and timely, we are now offering a class on-line.

Eligible alarm users who successfully complete the on-line course will receive a Certificate of Completion via e-mail. This certificate may be used in lieu of paying one false alarm penalty. The link for the class is at www.vallejopd.com, on the False Alarm Awareness page.

For those alarm users who do not have internet access, the Police Department is conducting the next class on Saturday, September 26, 2009 from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. The class will be held at the Vallejo Police Department, 111 Amador St, Vallejo in the Training Classroom.
