***REVISED* NOTICE TO ADOPT A MITIGATE NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Vallejo Planning Commission proposes to adopt a **MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION** for the following project pursuant to Resolution No. 96-447 N.C. adopted by the Vallejo City Council on December 10, 1996.

APPLICATION: Planned Development Unit Plan #08-0008

LOCATION: Drydocks 2 & 3 and surrounding Waterfront Area; Nimitz Avenue from 9th to Bagley Streets; Reuse Areas 4 and 5; Mare Island

DESCRIPTION: California Dry Docks Solutions is proposing to reuse Drydocks 2 & 3 and the adjacent area along the Mare Island Waterfront to provide services to accomplish ship re-fit and maintenance, repair, overhaul, new construction and dismantling. The initial phase of the project involves dismantling four decommissioned naval ships currently berthed in the Suisun Bay.

APPLICANT: Jay Anast, California Dry Docks Solutions

PROPERTY OWNER: Lennar Mare Island, LLC

CEQA FINDING: Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), an Initial Study has been prepared by the Planning Division, City of Vallejo, and it has been determined that with mitigations, the above project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
