

**PUBLIC NOTICE
CITY OF VALLEJO
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP), FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2010/2011**

The City of Vallejo may allocate a portion of its Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds to non-profit organizations for the provision of housing and social service programs to low- and moderate-income residents next year. The City may also allocate a portion of its Federal HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds to non-profit organizations for the provision of affordable housing programs and services to low- and moderate-income residents. In 2010, the City will accept proposals, hold public meetings, and determine the allocation of CDBG and HOME Program funds for FY 2010/2011, (July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011).

The Vallejo City Council has established the top priority needs of the community in the current Consolidated Plan. According to this Plan, the top priority needs in Vallejo are those of very low-income renters, low-income homeowners, homeless persons, and persons with special needs. The types of assistance identified in the Plan for these priority groups are: the development, rehabilitation, and ownership of housing; emergency shelter and related services; and facilities and services for the disabled, severely mentally ill, persons with substance abuse addictions, and persons with HIV/AIDS.

At this time, the City invites non-profit organizations to submit proposals to address the high priority needs in Vallejo. From the submitted proposals, the City will select organizations to receive CDBG and/or HOME Program funds, and provide programs and services.
