**CITY SEEKS TRANSIT RIDERS FOR MEMBERSHIP ON NEWLY-FORMED  
CITIZEN TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CTAC)**

The City of Vallejo is looking for area residents interested in serving on a Citizen Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC). Committee members will be chosen by the City of Vallejo Transportation Division staff, which intends to create a 10- to 15-member group that reflects a broad range of perspectives on transportation matters relating to the City's fixed route bus system and paratransit service. The committee is expected to meet monthly, on average.

The purpose of the Committee is to provide and foster meaningful public and user input to the City of Vallejo Transportation Division in the planning and monitoring of transit services as they relate to serving City of Vallejo transportation needs.
